- Heitkemper/ Elliott moved to move forward with the recommended list of projects for the ARPA funds in the amount of \$72,468.22 as recommended by the Committee of the Whole. Carried
- 2. Discussion/Action regarding 2024 Budget Discussion Kosmer informed the Council that she went line per line and increased some revenue line items like room tax since we get to keep more of that and went through some expenses, such as we no longer have a municipal building cleaner so she made those adjustments.

To aid with the library, we did a 3% budget increase to their budget, but then supplement the remaining money increase with the ARPA Funds as a revenue shortfall. Was able to get 3.5% increase to the fire department which was about \$3k. The budget presented also included a 4% salary increase for the Police department. Included in the numbers presented is the new full-time officer and police secretary/deputy clerk treasurer with the assumption that they will be a family plan for insurance, so these numbers may be adjusted once the positions are filled.
