2. Perkins/ Kempkes moved to call the Public Hearing to order:

Discussion: Request for a conditional use permit

Requestor: Price Co Mini Storage

Purpose: Request a conditional use permit to construct a 44'X130' building for self-storage units. The building will consist of 10'X24' units and 10'X20' units.

Heitkemper spoke to the Committee requesting another conditional use permit to build another self-storage facility. The one they had built last year is almost full and they would like an opportunity to build another one this year. He also wanted to note that he was planning on reducing the size of the unit to be 36'X130' to allow for more room to enter the units.

Huycke's, the neighboring property owner, was in attendance to contest the conditional use permit. They felt as though the contingencies that were put on the last conditional use permit were not met and do not feel it would be fair for the Committee to approve another conditional use permit

There was discussion as to what the issues were such as the landscaping and maintenance of the property as well as the rainwater. Currently, there does not seem to be a rain mitigation plan in place.

The Planning Commission would like to reconvene so they can have the DPW and W/S crews take a look at the properties and provide some assistance to questions the Committee may have at the September 8th, 2020 meeting.
